



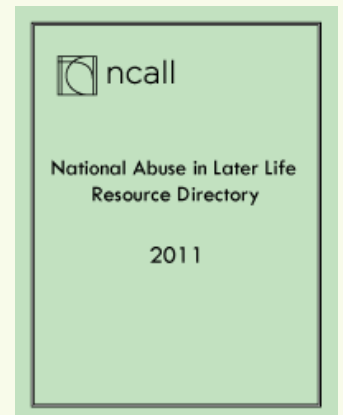
## 2012 Alzheimer's and Dementia Staff Education Week Tool Kit Now Available
