This workshop meets the mandatory course requirement for those seeking the path to certification as a Certified Dementia Practitioner (CDP) through NCCDP.

The workshop incorporated lecture, role play, discussions, and hands-on learning and covered the topics of Alzheimer's disease and related conditions that cause dementia, pseudo-dementia, the emotions experienced by elders with dementia and their families, prevention of behavioral expressions through anticipating needs and using best practices for approach, communication, and engagement, wandering and elopement, hoarding, paranoia and hallucinations, aggression and catastrophic reactions, life enrichment, environment, cultural diversity, team member burnout and stress management, and spirituality and end of life care.
