The tool kit and in-services are free and available at nccdp.org. The tool kit and in-services include many free Microsoft PowerPoint in-services to use for training your staff, family, volunteers, students, members and congregation. Download through March 15. Many of the in-services are designed to be taught in 30 minutes. Each year new in-services and topics are added to the archives.

The tool kit, In-services and the declaration by the NCCDP / ICCDP Alzheimer's Disease and Dementia Care Staff Education Week, Feb. 14-21, was developed to bring national and international awareness to the importance of providing comprehensive dementia education by means of an interactive classroom environment to all healthcare professionals, front line staff and first responders and to go above and beyond the minimum state or country requirements regarding initial dementia education and to require ongoing dementia education.
