Preston Place Community and the Village at Allandale offering new services to caregivers

Every 67 seconds, someone is diagnosed with Alzheimer's disease. It is the sixth leading cause of death in the U.S. There are currently over 5 million individuals living with Alzheimer's. If you are a family member, caregiver or friend of an individual suffering from this disease, there is some good news to share.

Preston Place Community and the Village at Alandale have provided training for 18 employees in this specialty field. The employees have completed a 12-hour training course provided by the National Council of Certified Dementia Practitioners. Sharon Durnin, Administrator of Preston Place II and a certified trainer for Administrator and Dementia care, conducted the training classes.

"The staff members are direct caregivers in our Memory Care facilities and, upon completion of this course, have received certification in Alzheimer's and Dementia Care," Dumin said.

Durnin is quick to point out that this training is no "magic bullet."

This training gives caregives a better understanding of the disease process and possible approaches to care, but is important to know that what works on edity with one person, may not work the exited year. It is available to anyone in the community, not just those who have family members in Preston Place or the Village at Allandale.

This new service was a natural progression of our Caregiver Support Group, which meets the first Tuesday of each month at 10 a.m., * Durnin explains.* There are so many people who have no idea where to go when they or a loved one crecive a diagnosis of Atcheimer's disease and we want to be one of the first places to differ them information and help—to at above all NDPC.*

"Establishing this resource center, coupled with our staff receiving this specialty training, enhances the caregiving skills that are needed to make a positive difference in the daily lives of those living with Atzheimer's Disease. We congratulate our employees!" Durnin said.
