The 136-page guide, now available on Amazon, outlines Lowther's approach to meeting the distinct needs of patients wherever they are on the continuum of the progressive disease, reflecting the philosophy of the individualized care provided at Tutera's Senior Living facilities across the country. "Families are easily overwhelmed with this difficult illness," Lowther said. "The book offers simple techniques I use every day with Tutera's residents to help caregivers build a successful relationship with the new person their loved one is becoming."

Lowther joined Tutera Senior Living & Health Care in 2011 as the director of life enrichment for Tutera's Stratford Commons Memory Care Community. In January, Tutera expanded Lowther's role as the director of life enrichment for the company's 47 senior living communities across the country, 11 of which offer memory care programming. Lowther extends her professional experience as a volunteer in the Kansas City area community where she is a member of the board of directors for the Kansas City Senior Theater. The nonprofit provides creative arts and aging programs that connect generations through life stories.
