Cathy Schill, the Administrator of Highland Oaks in Shippenville, and Reshawn Shipe, the Administrator of Ridgmont in Ridgway, have completed extensive training in the key aspects of Alzheimer's Disease and dementia care to become certified practitioners. .

The program taught the unique care techniques required for providing care to individuals with dementia, including communication strategies, interventions for disruptive behaviors and tools for addressing specific disease-related concerns such as wandering, aggression,

sexuality and poor nutrition.

"Dementia is prevalent among seniors," said Schill. "By increasing our knowledge level and skills as administrators, we can better serve the residents at Highland Oaks and Ridgmont. We can also provide additional training to my staff who are providing the hands-on care."
