Two of our personal care home administrators are now Certified Dementia Practitioners through the National Council of Certified Dementia Practitioners.

> Cathy Schill, the Administrator of Highland Oaks in Shippenville, and Reshawn Shipe, the Administrator of Ridgmont in Ridgway, have completed extensive training in the key aspects of Alzheimer's Disease and dementia care to become certified practitioners. .

The program taught the unique care techniques required for providing care to individuals with dementia, including communication strategies, interventions for disruptive behaviors and tools for addressing specific disease-related concerns such as wandering, aggression,

sexuality and poor nutrition.

"Dementia is prevalent among seniors," said Schill. "By increasing our knowledge level and skills as administrators, we can better serve the residents at Highland Oaks and Ridgmont. We can also provide additional training to my staff who are providing the hands-on care."

According to the National Council of Certified Dementia Practitioners, the benefits for an individual cared for by a Certified Dementia Practitioner is reduced risk for injury, enhanced recreational activities, sensitive psychosocial support for both the individual and their family, and better end of life care in the advanced stages of the disease.

The National Council of Certified Dementia Practitioners formed in 2001 by a group of professionals in the field of dementia care.

Its goals is to develop national standards for comprehensive and extensive dementia education and promote standards of excellence in the delivery of dementia care.
