Highlight the Rescue

On May 2, 2012 a man with Alzheimer's wandered away from his residence while his caregiver was taking a shower. The caregiver notified Project Lifesaver of Crown Point Fire Rescue at 1pm; dispatchers then alerted the Schererville Fire Dept. which covers the clients in the north part of the county, and the Lake County Sheriff's Department Aviation Unit, whom they train with regularly.

Chief Greg DeLor.: A signal was detected while the search teams enrooted to the clients last known location using the truck mounted antennae. Then they radioed our location to the other responding units and started a ground search. Our second responding unit located the client while leapfrogging past us toward the last known location. The client was located within minutes. The client's caregiver did the right thing and called us as soon as she realized he had left. The client managed to get about a mile and a half before we located him. The gated community has a central lake that is only a few hundred yards from the client's home.

He was found safe and unharmed and brought back to his caregiver.


